The facility includes security cameras, online rentals, and bill pay for tenant convenience and operational efficiency. It is being sold with Newton Mini Storage, located just 11 miles away at 620 & 628 W C Street in Newton, NC. Newton Mini Storage offers 64 standard units with approximately 4,600 RSF and includes two rental homes on the combined parcels, generating additional income. The Newton site also features paved drive aisles and perimeter fencing, and sits at a high-traffic intersection with 19,500 vehicles passing daily. Together, these properties present a diversified investment opportunity with multiple income streams in the growing Hickory area.
